Funds For Needs has a goal of 1,000,000 members by 2017 with both Vision Builders and Wealth Builders and any other membership class that is chosen to be included toward making this goal. A Charitable Trust can be set up for channeling income into a country, and a membership matrix is placed under the Trust that creates an income each month based on the number of members, not only from your area but throughout the world. Membership referral bonuses are paid each month based on how many members are in the Membership Matrix as described in the training link on the website. An aggressive campaign to enroll members from the US and all over the world will help to fill the matrix, and as it fills, more and more income will be produced to the individuals and to the Trusts created. The campaign will include going into non-profit organizations to present the cause, personal sharing the membership by word of mouth, internet, facebook, and social media, email campaigns, webinars, and other techniques of spreading the news of a unique way to benefit a worthy cause which will also create income for the one who helps and participates in the program

There will be qualifications for the ministry to share in the revenue from the Trust and is currently set at 100, but each individual will receive revenue from his own Membership Matrix. There is no time limit on this requirement, but when it is achieved the ministry is eligible to be paid their participating portion of the Trust income(Example...5 qualifying ministries receive 1/5 each of the Trust income monthly.).
